2. Prayer and Fasting Emphasis resources for use from 22 February – 07 April (Ash Wednesday – Easter Sunday during Lenten Period):

4. How To Start A Small Group: Use this guide to organize small groups for the Prayer and Fasting emphasis and in preparation for Bible Studies on our Core Values during the event between Easter and Pentecost.
5. Core Values booklet. Use this booklet to become familiar with the Core Values of the Church of the Nazarene before the main event begins on Easter Sunday.
6. Bible Study Lessons: Based on the Core Values of the Church of the Nazarene, these studies are for use each week between Easter Sunday and Pentecost Sunday.
7. Sermon Outlines Easter to Pentecost booklet: Use these sermon outlines during the event beginning on Easter Sunday and running through Pentecost Sunday. The additional sermons on Holiness are suggested for continued use throughout 2012.
8. Resurrection Power Easter to Pentecost Devotions: These devotionals for the entire family are designed for use during the Event from Easter Sunday through Pentecost Sunday.
